ALL TRIALS Will be held in accordance with the current Rules and Regulations of the Royal Kennel Club.

Dogs entered at Royal Kennel Club Licensed Field Trials must be registered at the RKC in accordance with RKC Regulations for Classification and Registration B.

This Society reserves the right to refuse entries.

There will be no substitution of dogs whilst reserves still stand. Reserves will be approached in strict order. If a reserve cannot be contacted despite all possible efforts, the next reserve will be offered the run. *This decision will stand even if the original reserve appears at the Trial.*

Withdrawals are subject to KC Rule J6f.

In the case of shared/joint ownerships ALL parties must be fully paid up members. Joint members may only run dogs owned in those members joint names. Joint members may not run dogs owned in their individual name.

All dogs resident outside the UK must be registered with a RKC *Authority To Compete* number before entry to the Trial can be made. All overseas entries without ATC numbers will be returned to origin.

If entries exceed the number of permitted runners, the right to compete shall be decided by ballot. Those applicants that do not get a run will have their cheques destroyed.

Should circumstances so dictate this Society, in consultation with the Judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes, and the circumstances surrounding them, will be reported to the Kennel Club.

No modification may be made to the Schedule after publication except by permission of the RKC, followed by advertisement in appropriate journals if time permits before the closing of entries.

Judges at a Trial are prohibited from entering a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership.

Videography and photography will only be permitted with the express permission of the Chief Steward and the Host.

Welfare of Dogs - all exhibitors (or competitors) whose dog is entered at a RKC licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under RKC Rules & Regs. The use of pinch, electronic or prong collars is not permitted at any Field Trial licensed by the RKC. This shall apply at the venue or within the precincts of the Trial.

Dogs in Cars on Hot Days - your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as only slightly warm. Please take care of your dog. If your dog is found to be at risk, forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.

Any complaint whatsoever about any Trial should be made direct to the Chief Steward on the day or in writing to the Secretary of this Club or to the Royal Kennel Club's Field Trial Department.
